



The Amazing Race Mission Rules & Regulations

1. Goal is to complete all challenges at all given locations. Team with the fastest time will be awarded the grand prize!
2. All Teams must consist of four (4) people and always stay together. You may not split up or have additional individuals join your team to complete challenges.
3. Teams must complete each challenge as specified by clues given to them to qualify for the grand prize.
4. When talking or interacting with strangers, business owners, or community members, all participants must be polite and respectful.
5. Must have one car per team. One participant on the team must be 18 years or older.
6. Don't speed! Drive safe and obey all traffic laws. Time will be marked for the arrival and departure of each team at each challenge location to ensure teams follow traffic rules.
7. All challenges must be completed, and pictures **MUST** be taken only during the duration of your race time (challenges completed outside this time frame will be disqualified).
8. Must take a photo with all off the team members at each location and DM the photo to our Facebook or Instagram @missioncommunityservices.
9. Time penalties can occur for violation of rules or not completing a challenge according to the instructions given. MCSS Amazing Race Mission organizers will apply all penalties to the final time for each team.
10. Winners will be posted on Sunday, August 15, 2021.
11. *Please note:* Cheating, stealing, sabotaging, removing items, or breaking the law will result in automatic disqualification.

***COVID-19 precautions:** participants are requested to wear masks. Social distancing protocols must be followed while interacting with other teams, event organizers/volunteers, and at challenge locations. The Amazing Race Mission will proceed in accordance with all BC Public Health Authority guidelines to ensure a safe experience for participants.
