COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAMS WITH GREATEST NEED



Family Place



Family Place offers a variety of on-site, outdoor and online programs for families with children 0-6 years of age with the goal of reducing isolation, increasing knowledge and confidence in parenting skills.



Meals on Wheels



Meals on Wheels is a healthy and affordable option for seniors who are at risk of isolation, have difficulty grocery shopping/ preparing their own meals. Subsidized, frozen meals are delivered by our friendly staff and volunteers every week.



Mobile Community Outreach Unit (MCOU)



The MCOU is a fully equipped healthcare facility on wheels designed to ensure that healthcare is accessible to everyone, promoting wellness and enhancing the overall health of our community. Currently we provide walk-in medical clinics and outreach support at 2 locations.



Engaged Community Guides (ECG)



ECG Ambassadors serve key areas of Mission by directing people to crucial social services and public resources; keeping the city's streets, sidewalks, and other outdoor areas clean; responding to urgent situations where needed, contacting relevant emergency services and lending a helping hand wherever they can.



Employee Readiness Program (ERP)



ERP is a stipend-based program designed to equip participants with valuable employment skills through hands-on, meaningful work. Participants (supportive housing clients who meet basic eligibility requirements) work on a variety of projects, including lawn care, moving assistance, and maintenance services. This helps them build their résumés, acquire transferable skills, and cultivate relationships that support their overall well-being. The program also enhances the living conditions of community members, particularly seniors.

In July 2025, MCSS hosted our first MCSS Community Day. The event was a tremendous success, raising over \$10,000 and welcoming **more than 550 community members for an evening of family fun**. Christmas Bureau

Christmas Bureau Wish Campaign is our largest fundraising campaign and community event of the year. It takes 4 months of planning and implementation and the involvement of approximately 30 staff and volunteers.

In 2025, we were provided holiday assistance to 1390 individuals through food hampers, toys and gifts (as applicable). 455 families received supports that included a total of 1044 children. We owe this outcome to the collaborative effort of our team, community partners and the generosity of the community as a whole.
